# **Continued Winter** Assistance Needed for Displaced and Vulnerable **Iraqis**

As winter temperatures set in, accompanied by winds and rain, the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Iraq has completed the threemonth distribution of 25,000 winter nonfood item kits. Consisting of heaters, blankets and jerry cans, the kits meet the most urgent needs of 150,000 vulnerable individuals across the country. Read more
